-We are reminded that the Lake Association can only take action with concerns of the lake. We can offer suggestions and advice to hopefully rectify other unfortunate situations.We all appreciate being apprised of the situations occurring in our community.

-The proposed by-laws were distributed and discussion followed.

-Since everyone needs time to read the by-laws in detail, we will have a **special meeting on Saturday, July 28th, at 11:00, at the Bidwells**. We are asked to direct our suggestions, corrections, and questions to Rich Bidwell or Jim McAndrew before the meeting. Our goal is to come to an agreement by then and vote on the by-laws.

-A postcard will be mailed to all members about this special meeting.

Meeting was adjourned at 5:35 to enjoy the picnic: great food, music, horseshoe tournament, games, and fireworks.
