The meeting was held at 1:00, Sunday, at the Hartman/Geiger home. 35 people attended.

The minutes of the Labor Day meeting were accepted. The address list was passed around for corrections.

Treasurer's Report: Anne Geiger reported we are in the 2nd year of a 3 yr. contract with Nature Works. The first payment of \$1,367 has been paid. There will be 2 more payments due totaling \$5,468 for the season. **Membership dues of \$150 are due now for this season.**22 people so far have generously pledged money to be founders. 7 people have paid for lake licenses. \$17,000 has been raised. Those monies will be used to purchase the lake and help defray ownership costs as explained in your packets.

Old Business:

- The **Packets** explaining the lake purchase proposal and costs, the new by-laws, and info on the corporation proposal were distributed last fall. All Lake Idlewild property owners and Idlewild Hts. property owners were asked to pledge money to be lake founders so that the lake purchase could move forward. **Those who as yet did not receive a packet: please let the officers know.** All property owners, whether Association members or not, should receive packets by the end of June, 2008. Pledges can be made immediately or by an installment plan.
- Discussion of lake purchase:
 - * Rusty Kauffman, present lake owner, will receive and give final say on by-laws as a corporate entity.
 - ❖ Diane Bidwell is waiting for final quote on liability insurance.
 - ❖ Jim McAndrew encouraged everyone to buy the \$15 lake license to ensure their lake rights forever. You record the lake license at the courthouse and then attach it to your deed. They will be transferable. No more licenses will be issued after Dec. of '09.
 - ❖ It was stressed that we still need funds to purchase the lake and all are encouraged to contribute and become founding members. (Membership dues are used for lake treatment and not lake purchase.) Jim McAndrew explained the fees as outlined in the packet. The pledges pay for :

Purchase of lake: \$10,500. Additional money is needed for legal fees, insurance, title insurance, and possible survey. Most of these fees are a one time fee. We are expecting to close before our July 5th picnic.

New Business:

- Dennis Palumbo volunteered to design a website for Lake Idlewild lake Association, Inc. Dennis will be the webmaster. Michele and Todd Schneider volunteered to host the website on their server at no charge to the lake association.
- Bill Oehler offered to survey the lake for \$3,500 which is a 30% discount from \$5,000. It would then be recorded at the courthouse. Discussion followed. Issue was tabled for now as it is not necessary to have a survey before closing in PA.

- Nominations for officers: Paul McElhaney made a motion to keep the same officers for this
 year. Ann Geiger resigned as treasurer (probably due to her new job as "Mommy of triplets").
 Bob Esposti was nominated as Treasurer. He accepted and all approved.
- Diane Bidwell announced that Mark Campbell is very ill in the hospital.
- July 4th picnic will be held on Sat., July 5th. All lake residents and guests are welcome, whether you pay dues or not, as everything is donated. Bob Breuche offered the use of the Idlewild Hts. facility again where we have had the picnic for the last 3 years.
 - ❖ It was decided to collect \$800 for the Smiths to buy the fireworks. They will be set off from their property again this year.
 - ❖ We will have nametags this year. Pick one up as you enter the picnic grounds.
 - ❖ There will be a horseshoe tournament with a prize for the winner.
 - ❖ We will have a \$5 --- 50/50. Tickets will be sold as you pick up your nametag.
